Preventative Services

Immunizations

Full panel of vaccines available by appointment only. The current federally funded program defers cost to patients. Those who don't qualify for the program may order needed vaccines at cost.

Vaccines For Children (VFC)



VFC is a federally funded program in which children birth to 18yrs can receive free vaccines. Check out www.cdc.gov/vaccines for current guidelines.

Pregnancy Screening

Women suspecting pregnancy may make an appointment for a free pregnancy screen required for WIC and Medicaid services. Education and referrals given as well.



Lead Screening

No cost. By appointment. Finger stick test for children to screen lead levels. All children need screened once between 9-12 months and repeated at 1-5 yrs for at risk.

We also have access to supplies to test your paint at home for lead content.
